Speed Week Entry Fee Policy

Pre-Entries

Competitors are encouraged to enter the Event as early as possible. Pre-Entry details can be updated prior to the Competitors Briefing at Speed Week. Pre-Entrants also have a number of options should their circumstances change.

Late Entry Fee

A late entry fee is applicable to any entries received after the gazetted Pre-Entry cut-off date and is payable at the time of making an entry. An entry is not considered complete until all fees are payable. Competitors are not permitted on the racetrack unless their entry is complete.

Withdrawals

Entrants may request to withdraw from the Event for whatever reason.

- 1. Notification must be in writing, as an email or on the prescribed form and must be lodged with registration prior to the Competitors Briefing. After that time a request to withdraw will attract a fee which will be equivalent to the late entry fee.
- 2. Acceptance by Registration to withdraw from the event will provide for 100% of the entry fee to be refunded.

Rather than withdraw from the event an entrant may elect to roll over their entry to the following year. Note; in the subsequent year the entrant must submit a new entry form for that year.

Roll-Over

Entrants may elect to roll-over an entry to the next Event. This is a form of deferment and is effective for 12 months only.

Notification must be in writing, as an email or on the prescribed form and be lodged with registration prior to the Competitors Briefing. After that time a request to roll-over will attract a fee which will be the same amount as the late entry fee.

After 12 months, in the absence of instructions from the entrant, entry fees are forfeited to the DLRA. The only exception to this is rule is where 2 consecutive or more Events are cancelled.

Transfers

Transfers of entry fees are permissible and can take place at any time.

- 1. All transfer requests must include a copy of the original entry form and a new completed entry form.
- 2. Transfer requests received after the pre-entry cut-off date will incur a Late Entry Fee.
- 3. A transfer is not considered complete until the new entry has been processed by registration. The new entry will then be subject to all the normal technical inspection processes.

Please note that you are NOT ALLOWED to transfer your number to another entrant without notification to and approval from Registration. Entrants using someone else's number can have very serious consequences i.e. if the participant suffers a medical emergency. The accuracy of the race results is also affected.

Any person who competes in using another entrant's race number without notification to and approval from Registration will be disqualified from the Event without refund.

Event Cancellation

The event is deemed to have started once the Competitors Briefing has commenced. No refunds will be given if the event is cancelled or postponed after this time.

- 1. There is no rain date for Speed Week.
- 2. The DLRA, in its sole discretion, may delay, postpone, modify, or cancel the Event if it believes the conditions on the race day are unsafe for any reason, including but not limited to acts of God or the elements (including without limitation, wind, water, rain, hail, hurricane, tornado, earthquake), acts of terrorism, fire, threatened or actual strike, labour difficulty, work stoppage, insurrection, war, public disaster, flood, unavoidable casualty, race course conditions, withdrawal of land access permissions, or any other cause beyond the control of the DLRA.
- 3. If the Event is delayed, postponed, modified, or cancelled prior to Event Start the DLRA will offer entrants the choice of a roll-over of entry to the next event or a 100% refund of any participant race fees.
 - The DLRA accept no liability for any other costs incurred by participants in connection with the event. Insuring against these other costs is the sole decision and responsibility of the race entrant.

The DLRA reserve the right to refuse or cancel entry applications, including duplicate applications, or alter the date of the event, the course route or distance.

The DLRA reserve the right to remove any participant from 'the Event', without refund, should the participants' behaviour endanger the safety or negatively affect a race, person, venue, him/herself, or property of any kind.
