# SALT ATTACK 2024 - ATTENTION SPEED WEEK 2024 PARTICIPANTS!

We're thrilled to inform you that there will now be an additional one and a half days racing for 2024. From Friday afternoon 15/03/2024 until Saturday afternoon 16/03/2024. The normal Speed Week will finish as usual at lunch time on the Friday and then the Salt Attack starts after lunch.

This means you will now have even more time to fine-tune your vehicles and make an attempt for that

elusive record. We believe that this new event will allow everyone to maximize their opportunities and reach their full potential.

SALT ATTACK

This is in response to many requests received over the last couple of years.

It took a bit longer than we would have liked to get all the organisation in place, as we had to confirm that our key services and volunteers would be available, and we had to renegotiate our permits. This meant we could not consider making Speed Week a six-day event. So, for 2024, at least, it will be a  $1^{-1}/_2$  day event. This will be something we can all discuss at the AGM as to what happens in future years.

To compete in the Salt Attack, you will need to register (see form included) and pay an entrant fee. The fee is based on the costs of running the event for the extra time divided by the number of entrants. There will be no refunds and no roll overs.

NOTE: Any records set during the SALT ATTACK will be considered to be DLRA Australian Records.

One of the major conditions for entrants to the Salt Attack is that they must all help pack up and I can't emphasise how important this is. There will still be lots of stuff not required for the Salt Attack to be packed up on the Thursday and Friday, so our normal volunteers will still be required to do this important work.

The event is open to all Speed Week entrants, and it will be limited to a total 30 entries. Cutoff for Pre-Entries for the Salt

Attack will be 26th February and then the entrants will be advised of their entry fee. Speed Week entrants will still be able to enter the Salt Attack at Speed Week if it's not fully subscribed.

There is already have six entrants signed up. It will be very interesting to see if this attracts more entrants and also spectators to watch some land speed vehicles go very fast.

Lastly thank you to all our Medical Team, Fire and Rescue Crew, Officials and Volunteers for supporting this event, without them this would not happen.

# SPEED WEEK 2024

The dates for Speed Week 2024 are 11th to the 15th March 2024.

Entry Forms are now available for Speed Week 2024, the final day for pre-entries is the 26th February 2024, and after that time late entries will attract a \$350 late entry fee.

Note that there is now a two year cutoff for roll overs and those people that are rolling over their entry from 2022/23 will need to complete a 2024 entry form and indicate that it is a roll over.

Also note, most members will still have to pay your annual subscription. Thanks to all those people who have already, this greatly helps the club and gives us increased confidence to commit our time and energy to making the DLRA the great club it is.

# WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECKS

Attention to all officials and volunteers, under South Australian law, anyone who has close contact with a person under 18 years of age should get a check. It is an offence to do child-related work without a Working with Children Check. We ask you to then send us a copy of the certificate to the club for our records. It is a very simple process all you need is 100 points of identification, and the checks are free. If you already have one from your state, that is acceptable as well.

# TECHNICAL UPDATES

## ADVICE FROM OUR CHIEF MOTORCYCLE INSPECTOR

The Special Construction classes are intended for race bikes modified beyond the Modified Class requirements. And purpose-built race bikes, not production bikes with minor modifications.

A special construction frame is unlimited in design, except for the class requirements of this section.

This class includes factory produced road racing or any other racing "works" models.

Bikes in this class must have either a full APS fairing or comply with two of the following requirements.

Here's a timely reminder for all entrants. Make sure all of your personal safety equipment (Helmet, suits, gloves, etc) is within date and has the correct tags on them. All the details are in the Rulebook.
